Horse Trial entry fee of \$40 includes Dressage, Cross Country and Stadium Jumping

Junior A – USEA 2014 Novice Test A – Maximum Jump Height 2' (17 or under on 11/1/2016)

Senior A – USEA 2014 Novice Test A– Maximum Jump Height 2' (18 or over on 11/1/2016)

Junior B – USEA 2014 Novice Test B– Maximum Jump Height 2'6" (17 or under on 11/1/2016)

Senior B – USEA 2014 Novice Test B – Maximum Jump Height 2'6" (18 or over on 11/1/2016)

(SCHEDULING NOTE: Stadium Phase will follow Dressage, with Cross Country Test last)

Awards: 6 Ribbons per Division, plus the following Perpetual Trophies:

St. David's Plate: Perpetual Trophy– Awarded to the Junior or Senior Rider with the best Cross Country Score – in the combined B Divisions. Time and faults to be included

Mary Roberts LaQuay Trophy for the best overall score of a Junior or Senior in the A Divisions. Overall Score to include Dressage, Cross Country and Stadium

COMBINED TEST – Entry fee of \$25 to include Dressage & Stadium Jumping test

For All Riders – USEA 2014 Novice Test B, Stadium Jumping Height Maximum of 2'3"

(Will Split Junior/Senior if entries warrant)

Awards: 6 Ribbons plus High % Score for Dressage Test

DRESSAGE: entry fee: \$15 per class

Classes as follows:

- 1 Walk-Trot– USDF 2015 Intro Test B
- 2 Training Level Test 1– USEF 2015 Test
- 3 Training Level Test 2 –USEF 2015 Test
- 4 Training Level Test 3– USEF 2015 Test
- 5 First Level– Any USEF 2015 First Level Test
- 6 Western Introductory Test 1 – WDA 2014 Test
- 7 Western Introductory Test 2 – WDA 2014 Test
- 8 Western Introductory Test 3 – WDA 2014 Test
- 9 Western Basic Test 1 – WDA 2014 Test

Awards: 6 Ribbons per class Plus High % Score Award CT Rider to include Dressage Tests for all Combined Training/Combined Test divisions, High % Score for English Rider in Classes 1 thru 5 and High % Score for Western Rider to include classes 6 thru 9

BHA DRESSAGE AND COMBINED TRAINING

RULES AND GUIDELINES

PLEASE NOTE: Since we have added the Combined Test Division, we will schedule as follows:

- **Combined Training Dressage followed by Stadium Jumping Test, Cross Country Last**
- **Combined Test Dressage followed by Stadium Jumping Test**
- **English Dressage Classes**
- **Western Dressage Classes**

Awards: 6 Placings awarded for each class & Combined Training Division

DRESSGE HIGH % AWARD WILL BE GIVEN TO:

Combined Training or Combined Test Rider in combined A and B Divisions

English Rider – Highest % score to include Dressage Classes 1-2-3-4-5

Western Rider – Highest % score to include Dressage Classes 6-7-8-9

ST. DAVID'S PLATE PERPETUAL TROPHY

A Perpetual Trophy will again be offered this year – the “St. David’s Plate”, donated by Dr. Laurence Roberts and Mr. William Jones. This special award is given to the Lowest Cross Country Score (including Time Faults & Course Faults) of a rider competing in the Junior Rider B or Senior Rider B Divisions. Ties will be broken by the best score, then nearest optimum time in Cross Country.

MARY ROBERTS LAQUAY MEMORIAL TROPHY

The family of Mary Roberts LaQuay has donated a trophy in her honor to be presented to the best overall score for a rider competing in the Junior Rider A or Senior Rider A Divisions. Ties will be broken by the best dressage score, then nearest to optimum time in Cross Country

JUNIOR RIDERS must be 17 or under on November 1 of the current year. Riders may compete in any open Dressage Class

SENIOR RIDERS must be 18 or over on November 1 of the current year. Riders may compete in any open Dressage Class

For Combined Training & Combined Test Divisions: Dressage Tests MAY NOT be read. Whips MAY be carried during Dressage Tests.

For Dressage Classes 1 thru 9: Tests MAY be read and Whips MAY be carried.
